Welcome to a new academic year. For some, it is another year that involves reaching new goals. For others, it is a world full of new experiences.

Class will begin promptly at 9:00 AM. Please make sure your child is here by that given time since circle time is the most important part of the day. If your child is not present for circle time, they will be at a disadvantage and the learning process will be more difficult for them.

Drop off will be between 8:00 and 8:55 AM. Remember that under new regulations, parents are not allowed to come inside the facilities. We will be receiving the kids outside; temperature checks and your signature will be required.

Pick up time is 1:30 PM. Teachers' shifts end at this time. Therefore, if you are late for pick up, your child will be waiting for you at the front desk with the academic coordinator, and a late fee will apply.

Please understand teachers are here to take care of your child, not their toys. TEACHERS WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR DAMAGED TOYS, JEWELRY, BOWS, Please make sure you label
EVERYTHING. We cannot emphasize
this enough. Water bottles, extra
clothes, sweaters, backpacks,
lunchboxes, utensils, and any containers
they bring their food in. Teachers cannot
be held responsible for the lost items if
they are not labeled.

If your child is sick please make sure you let us know.We respectfully ask to keep your child at home.

Please bring in a large Ziploc bag with extra clothes that we will keep in the classroom in case of an emergency. If for any reason you do not wish to leave the clothes in the classroom, you may simply send it in a backpack with them every day.

Make sure your child brings silverware everyday, as we do not provide it.

We kindly ask that you help us in bringing one packet of wipes for each child.

Children who are in the extended day program (the group that takes a nap) must bring a blanket every Monday. The blanket will be returned every Friday.

Communication between the school and parents is fundamental. For that reason we will be doing a group chat for each classroom. We kindly ask you to understand that teachers have their own schedule. Please try not to contact them at such late hours.


Every Friday we send the weekly activities and at the end of each quarter, the report card.

The art folder and their classwork notebook will not be sent home until the end of the school year.


DROP OFF/ PICK UP
